THE BIG SPRUCE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT

As of Monday, May 11th Wilco is back in town to complete Phase 1 construction. Phase 1 will be completed this year and includes three corners: Main & Second, Second & Matheson, Matheson & McClellan.

Phase 1 completion also includes all the landscaping from the roundabout, around the corner and down Main Street. Think GREEN!
